### <u>Directions to go to Santa Fe city from Ezeiza Airport "Ministro Pistarini" in Buenos Aires</u>

## Option 1: By plane from Jorge Newbery Airport (Buenos Aires) to Sauce Viejo Airport (Santa Fe)

To go from the Ezeiza International Airport to Aeroparque Jorge Newbery can take a taxi or the transport service "Manuel Tienda León".

You can request a bus in the hall of the airport, where there are also taxi cabs. From Aeroparque Jorge Newbery services there are daily flights to Sauce Viejo Airport (located 20 km from the city of Santa Fe). The companies that provide this service are "Austral líneas aéreas" and "Sol líneas aéreas". Schedules and reservations are available through the website <a href="https://www.aerolineas.com.ar">www.aerolineas.com.ar</a>.

The transfer Sauce Viejo - Santa Fe can be accomplished by the following taxi services available at the airport of Sauce Viejo:

### Option 2: Special bus from Ezeiza International Airport to an address in Santa Fe

From Ezeiza airport you can go to Santa Fe (address of each passenger) using the service of the company "Global vip": <a href="www.global-vip-transfer.com/reservas.html">www.global-vip-transfer.com/reservas.html</a>
This company collects the passenger at the airport of Ezeiza and takes him to the accommodation address, at preset times. It also has transfer services by private car at the times set by the passenger.

# Option 3: In special bus from Ezeiza Airport to the bus stations of Santa Fe or Rosario city.

From Ezeiza airport you can go to the bus station of Rosario city or the bus station or Santa Fe using the service of the company "Manuel Tienda Leon Rosario". This service must be booked two days in advance to the number 0810-888-5366 or ordered at the Ezeiza airport in the booths of the company. The frequency of services to Rosario is higher than that of to Santa Fe.

In the bus station of Rosario, there are numerous companies with direct links to the city of Santa Fe. The trip lasts about 2 hours, 20 minutes.

#### Option 4: By bus to Santa Fe from the bus station of Retiro (Buenos Aires city)

From Ezeiza Airport you can access to Retiro bus station using the service of "Manuel Tienda Leon". The bus should be board just leaves the hall of the airport, and it must be requested to go to Retiro bus station. The service runs approximately every 30

minutes from 6:00 am until 9:00 pm. The duration of the transfer from the airport to the bus station is about 1 hour and a half.

In Retiro station there are numerous companies with direct links to the city of Santa Fe. The trip Buenos Aires - Santa Fe is about 6 hours, and the price is AR\$ 450 or more depending on the type of service. **Important:** Since transfer from Ezeiza airport to Retiro station lasts about 1 hour and a half, it should be considered this time if you buy tickets Buenos Aires-Santa Fe via online. Those arriving at Aeroparque Jorge Newbery (Federal Capital Airport) can also take the bus "Manuel Tienda Leon" to get to the Retiro station. In this case, the Retiro bus station is relatively close, being more convenient to use a taxi service if there are two or more passengers.
